If you cannot access the website please ask a reception team member for a copy of our patient information booklet.

When you have completed the registration forms you will need to take them to reception with photographic proof of identity, such as driving licence or passport, and proof of address such as a bank statement or utility bill but not a mobile phone bill. Please ensure you complete all sections of the health questionnaire including the consent section. Please note that we cannot register you if you have not signed the purple registration form (GMS1).

If you are on regular medication which is issued each month please make an appointment with your usual GP within the next four weeks.

As you will have photographic proof of identity with you when registering please sign up for online access (SystemOnline). With online access you will be able to book appointments, request repeat prescriptions, view your summary care record and have access to your detailed coded record, subject to GP approval, which includes vaccinations, blood test results and your medical summary. Please note it is not Practice policy to give access to your full medical record. Parents are also able to apply for proxy access for a child up to the age of 11 years.

If you normally collect repeat prescriptions from the same place, or if you collect them on behalf of someone else, you could benefit from EPS (Electronic Prescription Service). Let a member of the reception team know your preferred pharmacy at the time of registration or speak to a dispensary team member if you decide to sign up to this service at a later date. The advantages to you are:

- you can collect repeat prescriptions directly from a pharmacy without visiting your GP
- you won't have paper prescriptions to lose
- you may spend less time waiting in the pharmacy
- the service is reliable, secure and confidential
